The show's long title quotes the title of a song by Massive Attack, SAFE FROM HARM, from the legendary album BLUE LINES (1991). It was selected for its associative ideas; the image of intersecting gazes, observation, and linguistic redundancy reflect the atmosphere of the exhibition. Beyond that, the song's mood and lyrics reflect both exemplarily and abstractly what the gallery's vision could be, while the works in the exhibition stand for aspects of artistic practice that represent the gallery.
